Technical Problems continue! We are still only broadcasting at 18 watts and less because of one piece of equipment not talking to another. The purchase of the STL's will allow us to broadcast without the horrible phone line! The signal will also go back to stereo.

Community Broadcasting Foundation

We have been successful in receiving yet another two grants lately – just over \$10,000 to upgrade our transmitter and buy and install STL's (stereo transmitter links which will enable us to get our signal from the studio to the tower and means we no longer have to broadcast via a shocking phone line!) and \$960 as assistance with the cost of site fees on the transmitter tower. We will be adding some programming from the CBAA as soon as we can obtain the necessary equipment etc.
